

NOTICE OF ASSERTION OF CONSTITUTIONAL RIGHTS

This letter is to inform you of the following:

- 1. The United States and Pennsylvania constitutions confer inalienable rights, that among those rights are the rights of due process and of equal protection.**
- 2. The constitutional rights of my child shall not be violated in the upcoming school year through contact tracing or any other COVID mitigation efforts.**
- 3. This notice is to inform you that should the school district continue to compromise itself in such a way, it will assume legal liability.**

The Delaware Valley July 2021 health and safety plan fails to account for the following facts and omits protection for due process and against discrimination.

- PCR tests are being recalled by the CDC as of December. They are invalid NOW and are therefore invalid evidence of COVID19.
- No appeal process for quarantine and isolation in violation of the Due Process Clause.
- Coercion and/or discrimination based on vaccination status in violation of the Equal Protection Clause.
- No asymptomatic spread.
- 99.9% recovery rate.
- No proof of COVID-19 has ever been identified and no proof of existence of a Delta variant.

The Pennsylvania Department of Education has clearly stated that it will not be providing any mandates on COVID-19 for the upcoming school year. The burden of determining the response to the alleged pandemic falls squarely on the school district. Facts matter when it comes to the implementation of public policy measures that impact the education experience of children. If the Health & Safety Plan is implemented as written, there will be no compliance until the District can articulate facts so that a rational and legal policy can be implemented, rather than rely on the hallucinations that underpinned last year's response.

You are hereby put on NOTICE:

1. Under no circumstances can you issue a quarantine order against my children under the Health and Safety Plan.
2. Under no circumstances can my children be ordered to wear a mask while on school property.
3. We do not consent to the administration of any COVID-19 testing or a COVID-19 vaccination on school premises.

We will hold all applicable parties, including individuals as appropriate, responsible in the event any of these demands are not observed.
